Youth Advisory Committe (YAC)



The BDNA YAC was formed in June 2023, as a way to encourage change based on youth feedback within our association. Due to the move to our new facility, the YAC's focus for the past year has been planning initiatives to introduce from Term 3 2024. This productive planning has resulted in 3 exciting initiatives which are already underway!

1. Container Deposit Scheme fundraising for BDNA: From Saturday 20 July, there have been donation bins around the courts for all to donate their recyclable containers. The funds raised will go towards further developments at BDNA.

2. Recycling old sports uniform & equipment: The YAC will be holding donation drives for all old sports uniforms (including old netball dresses & training gear) and equipment. These collections will be donated to charities which focus on making sport more accessible to all. Any club dresses donated will be handed back to the clubs for them to re-issue for second-hand use.
